

CHILDREN IN THE MIDDLE

Class and Registration Information

Please read before filling out the registration form.

Keep a copy of this form and the registration form for your records.

Each participant is required to pay according to the following fee schedule, which is based upon individual net income:

Net Monthly Income from All Sources	Seminar Fee
\$2,500 and above	\$70
\$1,500 to \$2,499	\$60
\$ 834 to \$1,499	\$35
\$ 833 and below	\$20
Fee Waiver by Court	\$ 0

Net income is determined by deducting taxes and Social Security from your gross income. Do not subtract any other deduction or payment.

You must include verification of your income with the registration form if you are paying less than the \$70 registration fee. Examples of income verification include paycheck stubs, photocopies of child support checks, welfare checks, unemployment checks, DSHS, TANF, SSI or government income. An order from the Superior Court may waive the fee.

To apply for the waiver you must go to the clerk of the superior court from **Monday through Thursday** to get a form, which you will fill out, and then appear before a judge to approve the waiver. The judge will review and if approved, you will receive a document from the court to present to LCSNW. The judge will review the waivers at **8:30 am and 3:45 pm only**. People should be at the courts **at least 30 minutes ahead of time** in order to complete the paperwork.

Please send a check or money order with your registration form. If paying in person, cash is allowed in the exact amount. Seminars are filled on a first-come, first serve basis. Once registered you will receive a confirmation notice with the seminar date, time and directions to the site. Upon completion, you will receive a certificate to be filed with the court.

**Please make arrangements for your children, as no childcare is available.
Children are not allowed at the class site.**

SECURITY: You will not be admitted to the seminar if you are carrying a weapon (per RCW 9.41.300) or you are under the influence of drugs/alcohol. You will be asked to leave the seminar if you exhibit behavior that is disruptive or threatening to the participants and/or facilitators.
