## OUR PROGRAMS

### Family Services

#### Divorce Lifeline

Group counseling for separated or divorced adults. Services provided by experienced professional therapists.

#### Parent Line

Providing child care information and referrals; a telephone “warm line” for routine parenting concerns; family support services; parenting classes; drop-in resource and referral; and Mt. Angeles View Family Center. Serves northern Olympic Peninsula communities.

### Foster Care & Adoption

#### Families For Kids

Serving families on the Olympic Peninsula and Eastern Washington through foster care recruitment and ongoing support to foster families.

#### Permanency Planning Foster Care & Adoption

Providing safe and stable foster homes for children 0-17 years with the goal of creating a permanent home. If the child is unable to return to their biological family, LCS foster families become the child’s adoptive family.

#### Refugee & Immigrant Children’s Program

Serving refugee and immigrant children from many countries who come to the United States without their families. We provide culturally and ethnically matched foster homes whenever possible.

### Immigrant & Refugee Services

#### International Counseling & Community Services

Serving the mental health needs of King County residents who are Medicaid eligible. Bilingual, bicultural counseling, support groups, outreach advocacy, and information and referral for refugees and immigrants residing in King and Snohomish counties.

#### Refugee Resettlement Program

Assisting newly arriving refugees resettling in the Puget Sound area. Services include assisting with housing, and referral to health care, education and employment services. Also providing immigration services for family reunification.
